

Individual Narrative of Abigail⁷ Leverich [136] Daughter of Edward⁶ Leverich [60] and Elizabeth Palmer

Abigail Leverich was born on 12 Aug 1795 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, the daughter of Edward Leverich and Elizabeth Palmer. The birth date is a calculated date based upon Abigail's age at the time of her death.¹

Abigail Leverich was baptized 22 November 1795 at the Newtown Presbyterian Church.²

"Abby" Leverich was accepted as a member of the Newtown Presbyterian Church in the year 1812.³

Abigail Leverich was likely living in the household of her father Edward Leverich in the 1820 U.S. Census of Newtown, Queens County, New York. At the time, Abigail was 25 years old, and the census tallies recorded two free white females age 16 to 25.⁴

Abigail Leverich died unmarried on 25 Dec 1823 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, at age 28. Abigail was buried at the Newtown Presbyterian Church.^{5,6,7,8}
