Richard Leverich was born on 27 Oct 1802 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, the son of James Leverich and Hannah Mott. The birth date is a calculated date based upon Richard's age at the time he died.<sup>1</sup>

Richard died as an infant on 20 Sep 1803 at Newtown, Queens Co, New York, age 10 months 23 days. He was buried in the Leverich Family Burial Ground in Queens County.<sup>2</sup>
