

Individual Narrative of Sackett⁷ Leverich [156] Son of James⁶ Leverich [62] and Hannah Mott Husband of Cornelia Duryee

Sackett Leverich¹ was born on 7 May 1798 at Newtown, Queens County, New York, the son of James Leverich and Hannah Mott.^{2,3}

Sackett married Cornelia Duryee, daughter of Abraham Duryee and Temperance Woodward, on 4 Feb 1823 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. They were married by the Rev. Mr. McMurray.^{4,5,6,7,8}

Cornelia Duryee was born 24 December 1806 in Manhattan, New York County, New York. Joseph Woodward Duryee, brother of Cornelia Duryee, was married to Cornelia Leverich, sister of Sackett Leverich.⁹

Sackett Leverich is listed in the 1824, 1825, and 1826 New York City Directories, grocer, 204 Division Street.^{10,11,12}

Sackett Leverich is not listed in either the New York City nor Brooklyn City Directories for the years 1827, 1828, and 1829.^{13,14,15,16}

Sackett Leverich is listed in the 1830 and 1831 New York City Directory, mahogany yard 577 Water Street. Sackett's brother-in-law, Jacob Duryee, is also listed in the 1830 and 1831 New York City Directory, mahogany yard 577 Water Street.^{17,18}

A Sackett Leverich is recorded in the 1830 U.S. Census of Manhattan, Ward 7, New York Co, New York. The census tallies record 1 free white male age 30 to 39 (1791-1800) and 1 free white female age 20 to 29 (1801-1810). Adjacent in the census record is Jacob Duryee. These tallies fit both Sackett Leverich (1798-1838) and wife Cornelia (born c 1806), son of James Leverich; as well as Sackett Leverich (1795-1839) and wife Clarissa (born c 1801), son of Gabriel Leverich. The record more likely pertains to Sackett and Cornelia Leverich, due to the proximity of Cornelia's brother Jacob Duryee.¹⁹

Sackett Leverich is not listed in the 1832 to 1838 New York City Directories. Jacob Duryee is listed in the 1832 to 1838 New York City Directories, mahogany yard, 577 Water Street.^{20,21,22,23,24,25,26}

Sackett Leverich died on 9 Mar 1838 probably at Manhattan, New York County, New York, at age 39. Neither the cause of death at the young age of 39 nor his place of burial have been determined for Sackett.^{27,28,29}

During the period 1839 to 1848, widow Cornelia Leverich is not found in city directories for Manhattan, New York, or Newark, New Jersey. During this period of time, it is likely that Cornelia and her two sons were living in the household of another family member.^{30,31,32,33}

Joseph Woodward Duryee, brother of Cornelia Duryee Leverich and brother-in-law of Sackett Leverich is recorded as the head of a household of 13 persons in the 1840 U.S. Census of Newark, Essex Co, New Jersey. The census tallies account for all of Joseph's family, plus 3 additional unidentified tallies, i.e. 1 free white male under age 5; 1 free white female age 10 to 14; and 1 free white female age 30 to 39. These may represent widow Cornelia Duryee Leverich age 34 and her son Joseph Woodward Duryee Leverich age 4. Unaccounted for is son Sackett Leverich Jr age 9. Sackett Leverich Jr may have been living at the time in the household of another family member.³⁴

Cornelia Duryee Leverich, widow of Sackett Leverich, as well as her sons Sackett Jr and Joseph W.D., are not found in the 1850 U.S. Census.³⁵

Cornelia Leverich, widow, is listed in the Brooklyn City Directory during the period 1849 to 1855:

- 1849-1850: seamstress, 110 Gold Street;
- 1850-1851: seamstress, 110 Gold Street;
- 1851-1852: widow, seamstress, 187 Gold Street;
- 1852-1853: widow Sackett, 187 Gold Street;

- 1853-1854: widow Sackett, 187 Gold Street; also listed is her son Sackett, ship carpenter, Concord near Gold;
- 1854-1855: widow Sackett, 155 Concord;
- 1855-1856: widow Sackett, 18 Chapel.^{36,37,38,39,40,41,42}

18 Chapel Street in Brooklyn was the residence of Horace and Ann Brown, as per the 1855 New York State Census. Ann was the sister of Cornelia Duryee Leverich, and Horace was Cornelia's brother-in-law. Cornelia is not recorded in the 1855 household, having died that year. However, Cornelia's son Sackett is recorded in the household, age 24, ship joiner.⁴³

Cornelia Duryee Leverich died at Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York on 13 June 1855. Her funeral was held from the residence of her brother-in-law Horace Brown 18 Chapel St in Brooklyn. A place of burial has not been determined for Cornelia.⁴⁴

Sackett Leverich and Cornelia Duryee had two children.^{45,46,47}

- i. Sackett Leverich, Jr was born in March 1831 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. The birthdate is based on the 1900 U.S. Census. Sackett married Mary Woodruff Fricke 3 September 1857 at Babylon, Suffolk Co, New York. Sackett died 6 August 1905 at Babylon and was buried at the Babylon Rural Cemetery.^{48,49,50,51,52,53}
- ii. Joseph Woodward Duryee Leverich was born 20 December 1836 at Manhattan, New York County, New York. Joseph married Elizabeth A. Burns 11 June 1857 at Brooklyn, Kings County, New York. Joseph died 25 April 1917 at Newtown, Queens County, New York and was buried at Cypress Hills Cemetery in Brooklyn.^{54,55,56,57,58}

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
