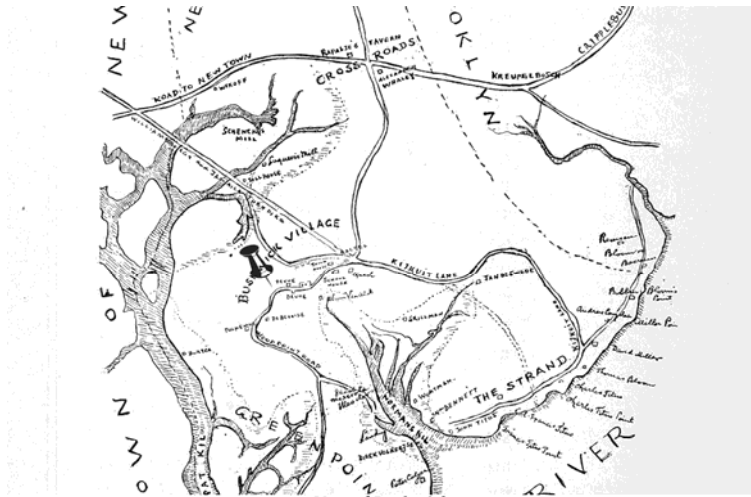


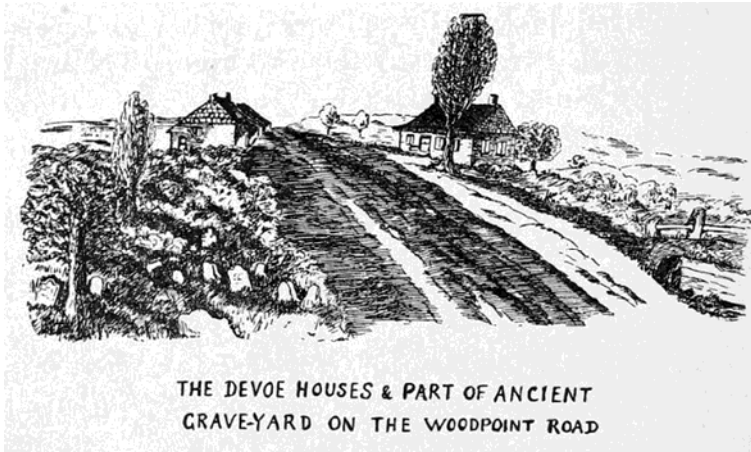
Individual Narrative of Praw⁷ Devoe [168] Son of Frederick Devoe and Sarah⁶ Leverich [63]

Praw Devoe was born on 24 Jun 1804 at Bushwick, Kings Co, New York, the son of Sarah Leverich and Frederick Devoe. Praw was baptized at the Bushwick Reformed Church on 26 August 1804.^{1,2}

Praw died unmarried at the age of 23 on 25 Dec 1826 at Williamsburgh, Kings Co, New York. Praw was buried at the Bushwick Reformed Church graveyard. On 7 April 1851, he was reinterred at the Evergreens Cemetery in Brooklyn, Kings Co, New York.^{3,4}
